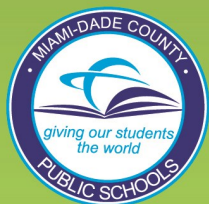

Once her youngest child celebrated his third birthday, Ms. Mohamadullah was able to enroll at the North Miami Adult Educational Center. In only three months, she completed her ESOL studies. Wasting no time and with the encouragement of the schools' staff and her fellow students, she began taking coursework in the health field.

In her early years, Ms. Mohamadullah was determined to become a strong, independent, educated woman. She always believed in standing up for woman rights and helping those who are most in need.
