Having her son motivated her to move from Honduras to the United States because she knew it was here where she and her son had a chance at a better life and future.

After arriving in the United States in 2015 with just herself and her son, she worked hard to become an independent mother and continued her studies to find a steady career. She wanted to have more job opportunities open, and improving her English was the first step. She started to look for a school that could fulfill both her language and career studies.
