

Comprehensive Refugee Services (CRS) Miami-Dade County

The CRS program provides services to foster self-sufficiency and to facilitate integration the community to refugees, new entrants and their families during the first 60 months of arrival.

Services:

Assessment and Case Management: Through in-depth assessment and different levels of case management, we evaluate individual needs and provide specific services to help refugees and their families to achieve economic self–sufficiency and integration to the community.

Employment Services: Help eligible refugees and new entrants to get prepared for the job market and get jobs aligned with their individual skills and talents. Pre-employment services include: counseling, employability skills training, vocational education, and job placement services. Career laddering services include: career planning, job placement assistance and on-the-job training opportunities.

Referral Services: We provide referrals to programs that include: ESOL classes, adult basic education, GED education, legal services and other services.

Youth Services: Focus on promoting academic success through 2 different pathways: Academic Pathway (for youth 16-18 years old) and Career Pathway (for youth 16-19 years old).

Mentoring Services: Fosters social engagement, educational and vocational development. Connects youth refugees 15 to 24 years of age with mentors who provide guidance, support and serve as role models for their future.

Child Care Services: Is a service provided to eligible refugee/entrants who are enrolled in the refugee employment services or adult education services. Referrals for child care assistance are submitted through an online form at: <u>https://www.ycoop.org/child-care-referral/</u>
